



FD – Traditions and Wines

Descripciorn del circuito:

At 105 kilometers from Valparaíso is the fertile **Aconcagua Valley**, one of the most important in terms of agriculture, livestock and fruit growing. At the foot of the majestic Cordillera de Los Andes, this zone huasa, is protagonist of traditional creole festivals like the "threshing loose horse", domination of ponies or rodeos and an environment where we can find small towns rich in history and tradition.

We will visit the **Colonial Museum Convent of San Francisco de Curimorn** built in the XVIII century and restored in the year 2012 that houses a collection of historical and religious documents of the time. It is an adobe construcciorn with walls of 1 meter of thickness and was place of passage of the priests to Mendoza (museum closed the Mondays).

A great attraction of the valley are the vineyards that produce wine, we can visit one of them, have a tour of its facilities and taste the wines they offer. The main characteristic of this valley are the artisan systems of wine production and other typical liqueurs such as chicha, aguardiente, Pipeño wine and mistelas (grape liqueur, aguardiente, canelita, vintage wine, among others).
