### Tour description:

A wine lovers tour... two prestigious wineries joined in a marvelous experience.

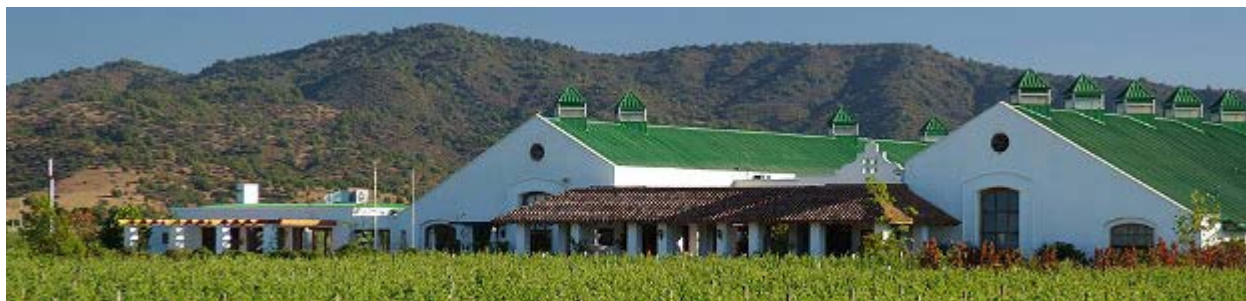
### Casas del Bosque Winery:

A boutique vineyard that produces premium wines and that has gained great prestige over the years. In 2010 it became the best vineyard to visit in Chile. Besides its restaurant Tanino, was chosen among the best cuisines. Both the 2013 and 2014 in London, England, was chosen by the "International Wine & Spirits Competition" contest as "The Chilean Wine Producer of the Year".

Today, the vineyard has 235 hectares (one unit), dedicated to producing cold climate varieties: Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Riesling, Pinot Noir and Syrah.

The enological team on charge by wine production has been run since 2009 by the New Zealand winemaker, Grant Phelps.

Another aspect that makes unique to Casas Del Bosque Winery is the fact that all 100% white wines are harvested at night (this will take advantage of low temperatures between 3°C and 8°C). This is followed by a prolonged period between five and nine days of skin contact before pressing.





### **Matetic Organic Vineyards:**

Matetic history begins in 1999 when the Matetic Family decided to diversify its business and enter the world of wine, believing strongly in the climate and soil benefits of Valle del Rosario.

Of vital importance for Matetic (from the beginning and today too) is to have a professional team to guide this project. It is for this reason that late 2000 joined Alan York (biodynamic production consultant) who along with his team makes Matetic wines achieve the high quality desired.

Matetic Vineyards 3 has three vineyards and each is dedicated to the production of different wines as Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Gewurztraminer, Riesling, Malbec, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Franc and Syrah.

The wines are made under a biodynamic philosophy, certified by Demeter-Germany, with 100% organic grapes and with particular attention to the surrounding environment.
